





Of the many perceptions changed over the last year dealing with the pandemic, perhaps the most glaring (especially for those of us who work in it) is the spotlight that has been shone on the logistics industry. The effort and workings of how goods move through supply chains has a much more prominent spot in the minds of consumers now. It is also easier than ever to see Utah's role as an ideal logistics hub.

While the idea of an inland port in Utah has been around for decades, the events of the last year have helped solidify the vision of the Utah Inland Port Authority (UIPA). No longer do we consider the goal of an inland port to be a facility or development in a specific area of land. The vision for the Port Authority has grown to encompass the entire landscape of logistics, as a whole, in Utah.

So, what does this mean for the trucking industry in our state? What are a couple of myths that might be out there, and what is the reality?

The first myth:

The Utah Inland Port Authority is only focused on rail, and not trucking.

Here is the reality: UIPA is focused on promoting logistics systems that are efficient, smart, and sustainable as we move into the future. This includes balancing our trucking strategy with rail and other modes of transport. Trucking is critical, especially for in-state, drayage, and other last mile needs.

One of UIPA's urgent and immediate priorities is to expand the availability of overnight parking options for trucking. It is no secret that there has been a significant deficit in overnight parking for years, particularly in the Salt Lake area, but also state-wide. This results in truck drivers seeking accommodations in less-than-ideal locations which may create security and safety concerns for both drivers and their cargo. This also causes potential losses in delivery efficiency as some drivers may stop at the first available parking location, potentially far short of the ideal stop, to avoid risking an end-of-service infraction while searching for a spot. Given the current shortage of drivers, eliminating any job-related stress is a critical need for driver retention.

Furthermore, as we expand our parking for trucks, we will provide robust auxiliary power infrastructure options which will greatly assist to eliminate needless idling. This in turn will reduce overall fuel cost, limit emissions, and reduce the impact of noise in the parking areas (another bonus for drivers!)

The Port Authority has been working to create partnerships to expand the availability of overnight and long-term parking, and we expect to see an acceleration of options over the next six months and beyond.

Here is the reality: UIPA is not a regulatory agency and therefore, cannot mandate use of a particular fuel source. As part of our mission to improve the availability and infrastructure for green sources for logistics movement, we seek out programs and partnerships that support innovation for sustainable energy and fuels.

More and more customers are insisting on alternative or advanced fueling options. The UIPA is working to build the infrastructure to help ensure that our Utah trucking companies can readily meet this demand. However, this also means that we need an open dialogue with Utah trucking businesses to serve as a resource for those interested in making changes to their fleets or operations.



Logistics is about the system, and we are all part of Utah's system. UIPA looks forward to working together to put Utah at the forefront of logistics systems in our nation.

Many people are aware of emerging technology in self-driving personal vehicles (as made popular by companies like Tesla and Google). However, just as important are the advancements made in self-driving commercial vehicles and in the trucking industry. Billions of dollars are being invested every year in the race to reach a complete level of autonomous driving.

Investors are betting that autonomous trucks will greatly improve safety and efficiency in the trucking industry. It is no secret that truck drivers face one of the most dangerous jobs in the nation. In the last few years, injuries and fatalities from trucking accidents have been increasing to all-time highs. Studies have found that approximately 90% of trucking accidents stem from human error. Additionally, many companies are suffering from driver shortages. In fact, reports indicate that there is a national shortage of up to 60,000 drivers. Autonomous trucks may be the answer for many of the problems the trucking industry is facing.

Ideally, autonomous trucks will not get distracted, can operate longer without rest or breaks, and will have a much better reaction time than a human driver. Current technology already allows autonomous trucks to detect objects and vehicles almost one mile away, and this will likely only increase with ongoing advancements. Most autonomous trucks have full 360-degree awareness and can collect and analyze amazing amounts of data. This data can be shared and adapted by entire fleets of vehicles in a matter of minutes, improving efficiency and safety.

Autonomous trucks are already making deliveries and test runs throughout the United States. In fact, one company recently reported that its autonomous truck completed an 800-mile drive without driver intervention. Another company is operating seven routes autonomously from Phoenix to Dallas. Yet another company offers add-ons to any truck for \$5,000 to allow for adaptive cruise control, emergency braking, and automatic lane centering.

With these new technologies comes new challenges. The trucking industry will need to adapt its strategy for employment, accident investigation, and liability defense. Attorneys who are prepared for changes in the industry will be able to assist business as it embraces the future.



Truck drivers should see your job advertisements every time they open their phone, tablet, computer, etc.

This can be accomplished by combining social media advertising, posting on job boards, search

engine optimization, and pay-per-click advertising.

Once drivers are seeing your advertisements every time they get online then they will always have your company on their mind. Digital advertising only gets drivers aware of your company. To get the application you also need to have an attractive offer. It does not matter how many ads drivers see if your job advertisement is a bad position.

The most important element of a good job position is the pay. However, drivers care about more than just the money. Quality truck drivers want to work for companies that have a supportive company culture, have newer trucks, promote from within, and work with their drivers to get the schedule they desire. A combination of a great job offer and widespread exposure will get truck drivers applying for your positions.

Hiring Truck Driver Applicants

Generating truck driver applicants is merely step one for escaping Truck Company Purgatory. The next step is hiring drivers who apply. Hiring truck drivers comes down to speed and organization. Time is of the essence, as soon as the driver hits submit on your application the clock starts ticking. Keep in mind that drivers are oftentimes applying to multiple carriers at once. The odds of contacting a lead are 100 times higher if called in 5 minutes versus 30 minutes. The odds of qualifying a lead are 21 times higher if called in 5 minutes versus 30 minutes. Applicants that receive a call immediately after submitting their application exhibit an emotional response.

That emotional response creates a feeling like, "this is a company that truly wants me to be a part of their team."

In addition to being fast, your recruiters need to be organized. The best way to stay organized is by utilizing a quality applicant tracking system. Using an ATS will enable your recruiters to keep track of all the drivers they are in communication with and the driver's information. Keeping track of drivers and their information ensures that recruiters do not allow for a driver to fall through the cracks or confuse any two applicants. Combining speed and organization provides a huge advantage for your recruiters to hire the drivers that apply to your company. Once you have these two elements down all that is left is collecting the driver's information

Retaining Your Truck Drivers

Ask any person in the industry and they will tell you that the most important factor of driver retention is money. Pay your drivers more and they will stick around. However, There is much more to truck driver retention than paying them more money. Yes, pay is one of the most important factors but truckers care about things beyond money.

If your company is small then it may not be able to afford to pay truckers top dollar.

One way

you can work around this is by offering high-performance bonuses. All that matters with the

performance bonuses is that the action needed to receive the bonus can be easily tracked by

the company and the driver.

On top of pay, you need to go above and beyond to make drivers feel valued. Quality truck

drivers want to work for a company where their hard work is appreciated.



The bottom line, driver retention comes down to paying your drivers a competitive wage and then going above and beyond to show your drivers they are appreciated. Truck company purgatory can feel like an impossible situation to escape. How can you afford to pay more drivers if your trucks are on the fence not earning money? Take things one step at a time. Start by generating more applications, then focus on hiring those applicants, and finally

use the increase in revenue to improve driver retention. Focus on one step at a time and before you know it, you will be in truck company heaven.




