Each September, the Utah Trucking Association proudly joins the national celebration of Driver Appreciation Week, honoring the men and women who keep freight — and the American economy — moving day after day. This year's event, held September 15–18, 2025, was one of our strongest showings yet, bringing together an impressive number of volunteers, industry partners, and state agencies to express gratitude to Utah's professional drivers.

Kicking Off with Community Support

Monday, September 15 set the tone for the week as more than 30 volunteers gathered at the UTA building to assemble goodie bags. What has traditionally taken UTA staff over eight hours to complete was finished in an astonishing 40 minutes thanks to the remarkable turnout. Together, participants stuffed over 1,000 bags, each filled with beef sticks, gum, granola bars, and other fun treats — small tokens of appreciation meant to brighten a driver's day.

Delivering Gratitude Across the State

For the rest of the week, volunteers traveled across Utah, distributing bags at multiple Ports of Entry to reach drivers in every direction:

Tuesday, September 16 – Echo Port of Entry Volunteers handed out 250 bags to drivers entering Utah from Wyoming.

Wednesday, September 17 – Perry Port of Entry Another 250 bags were delivered to drivers just outside Brigham City. Thursday, September 18 – Two Locations
The group divided and conquered — one team at the
Wendover Port of Entry and another in St. George.
Both teams distributed 250 bags each, reaching drivers traveling from Nevada and those entering from the
south.

In total, 1,000 goodie bags were shared with professional drivers across the state, each one met with gratitude, surprise, and a genuine sense of connection.

A Week of Appreciation and Collaboration

Driver Appreciation Week continues to be a powerful reminder of just how essential our professional drivers are. Their dedication keeps shelves stocked, businesses running, and families supplied with the essentials of daily life.
